The Parade

Cortana Kiwanis Foundation announced that over the next 3 years, the net proceeds from the Christmas parade will primarily benefit the Baton Rouge Children's Advocacy Center and the Baton Rouge Youth Coalition. Each charity will receive one-third of the annual net proceeds from the 2023, 2024, and 2025 Christmas parades. The remaining one-third will be allocated to providing grants to other charities in service to children that apply for support.

Since 1948, the Cortana Kiwanis Christmas Parade has drawn tens of thousands to downtown Baton Rouge every December. The parade is a family friendly-event, and provides merriment and joy in each element of the evening.

As important as the parade is to many worthy causes Cortana Kiwanis supports year round, it's also a powerful economic magnet that attracts vendors, shoppers, restaurant customers, hotel guests, and tourists to our city's downtown area. The large crowds come early and stay late, shopping and eating before and after the parade rolls.

The Cortana Kiwanis Christmas Parade is the largest televised Christmas parade in the Greater Baton Rouge area, and it draws attendees from all over South Louisiana, Alabama, Texas and Mississippi. Our broadcast airs throughout the state, on television and online, thanks to Yurview Cox Communications Louisiana and WAFB-TV, and receives significant coverage on local iHeartMedia, Guaranty Media and Cumulus Media radio stations.

The Cortana Kiwanis Annual Christmas Parade has been named the Top Signature Project for the Kiwanis International Signature Project Winner for the Louisiana, Mississippi and West Tennessee District.

THE FOLLOWING MUST BE ADHERED TO BY ALL PARTICIPANTS. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHALL THIS STEP BE OMITTED. PARADE COORDINATORS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REMOVE YOUR ENTRY FROM THIS PARADE FOR NOT ABIDING BY THE RULES OUTLINED BELOW.

- A Hold Harmless Agreement must be signed by all parade participants.
- No Santas permitted (the real Santa comes at the end of the parade)
- No alcoholic beverages are permitted. No vulgarity will be permitted. Participants are not allowed to have or be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Tow and trailer length not to exceed 40 feet without written permission from parade officials.
- Once the parade begins, please turn off your vehicle headlights.
- Should your tow or trailer experience a breakdown of any kind, a \$250 wrecker fee will be charged to pull your unit off the parade route.
- If your entry includes animals of any kind you will be required to clean up after them during the parade.
- It is your responsibility to provide a minimum of six walkers to accompany your entry during the entire parade route.
- All walkers must sign the Hold Harmless Agreement.
- You or an authorized representative of your organization's entry must attend a mandatory safety meeting on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>November 15th at 5:00P.M at the Coca-Cola Bottling Company at 9696 Plank Rd.</u>, <u>Baton Rouge</u>, <u>LA 70811</u>.
- Drivers must produce license, insurance, and registration before the safety meeting for all vehicles and trailers to be in the parade.
- All vehicles in the parade must have a current inspection sticker or they will be pulled from the parade route.
- Do not stop on the parade route unless directed to do so by parade officials.
- All vehicles in the parade must have a parade number that will be issued at registration
- In the event that the parade is canceled due to weather or edict from city officials, your fee will be considered a donation to Kiwanis Club of Cortana Baton Rouge Foundation, Inc. No refunds will be issued.
- Any music played by your group must be Christmas family-friendly. No vulgar lyrics or profanity
- Your float, vehicle or other related parade unit must be decorated in the Holiday theme.
- Standard family-friendly throws only. No damaging materials or projectiles or profane materials will be permitted.
- No lewd, suggestive, or profane costumes are to be worn in the parade. We strive to always uphold the standards of being a family-friendly event. Any violations of this standard will be grounds for removal from the parade line.
